It is true that the suffering in this world is the main reason people say that they don't believe in God

Let's look at suffering from 2 aspects

Intellectual side

Many use this as a reason why they don't believe in God

If we say there is no God, the problem of suffering still exists!

But if there is no God, there is also no hope

Atheism provides an intellectual answer to suffering but provides no hope, and therefore, does not address the issue of justice!

Emotional side

Christians claim that Jesus is God incarnate, who was without sin

The real question should be "Why is God on a cross?"

It shows that God is not distant from human suffering but is part of the suffering

And this shows a window into the heart of God, which provides strength for us

Even when there is no relief in the suffering this side of eternity - there is still Hope!

HOPE

As a Christian, I believe Jesus was crucified and raised on the third day

And, therefore, death is not end!

We believe that there will be justice and that God will address the suffering
